



SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Uniform • Grooming • Discipline

The school uniform is an important part of the identity and discipline of our school. Students are expected to come to school in the prescribed uniform, properly groomed and neatly dressed, according to the schedule given below.

1. KINDERGARTEN

Winter Uniform – Kindergarten

During winter, students of Kindergarten will wear the prescribed Carbon Blue Winter Full Jacket along with the regular school uniform.

2. CLASSES 1 TO 10

Regular Uniform

- Boys: Carbon Blue Trousers, Self-Checked Sky Blue Shirt, and school-prescribed Tie and Belt.
- Girls: Carbon Blue Trousers, Self-Checked Sky Blue Shirt, and Carbon Blue Half Jacket.

Winter Uniform – Classes 1 to 10

- Classes 1 to 5: Navy Blue Sweater along with the prescribed uniform.
- Classes 6 to 10: Carbon Blue Blazer along with the prescribed uniform.
- The prescribed winter uniform applies to both boys and girls.

3. CLASSES 11 & 12

Regular Uniform

- Boys: Carbon Blue Trousers and Striped Sky Blue Shirt.
- Girls: Carbon Blue Trousers, Striped Sky Blue Kurta, and Carbon Blue Half Jacket.

Winter Uniform – Classes 11 & 12

During winter, students will wear the prescribed Self-Checked Dark Blue Blazer along with the regular school uniform. The winter uniform applies to both boys and girls.

4. SHOES, SOCKS, TIE & BELT

Regular Uniform Days

- Boys and Girls: Black Shoes with Navy Blue Socks.
- Boys (Classes 1 to 12): School-prescribed Tie and Belt are compulsory.

House Uniform Days

- Boys and Girls: White Shoes with Navy Blue Socks.

Students are expected to wear the prescribed school shoes, socks, tie and belt as applicable. These should be kept clean and in good condition.

5. PERSONAL GROOMING & DISCIPLINE

Students are expected to maintain a neat, clean and well-groomed appearance at all times.

Boys

- Hair should be neatly trimmed and kept above the collar and the ear lobes.
- Senior boys are required to come to school clean-shaven.
- Hair should be kept neat and in accordance with the school's grooming standards.

Girls

- Hair should be neatly pleated into two plaits and properly tied.

NOTE

Sikh boys may wear a Navy Blue Turban as part of the prescribed school uniform.

All students are expected to strictly follow the prescribed uniform schedule and grooming standards. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward comes to school in the correct uniform, neatly dressed and properly groomed.
